



## **Sending Out Laborers    Luke 10:1-16**

### **Something to Start Us Off**

- Have you ever been sent out to represent anyone? If so, can you describe some of your responsibilities in that situation?

### **Something to Notice**

- Take a good look at v.10. Where exactly was Jesus sending the seventy-two disciples?
- What are some of the things Jesus told them to do – or not do – on their journey?
- Which of these things stands out the most to you?
- Which of the consequences Jesus mentions in 10:10-15 stands out the most to you?

### **Something to Understand**

Read Luke 22:35-37. How do Jesus' words contrast with what he says here in Luke 10?

What do you think the two passages together tell us about certain rules for carrying out any given ministry today?

- In what ways do you think the prayer Jesus recommends in v.2 is still applicable to us?
- What does it mean to be sent out as lambs in the midst of wolves (v.3)?
- Why do you suppose Jesus put these various limitations on this group of disciples?
- Read v.16 carefully. What implications do you think there are for those who reject the gospel today?

### **Something to Take Home**

- After this week's study, name one thing that we should keep in mind if we want to faithfully represent Jesus today.
- Is there anything else from this look at Luke 10:1-16 that you especially want to remember for future reference? Can you explain why?
