- Describe the response of the people and of Paul in Acts 21:12-16.
- How do the elders in Jerusalem respond to and advise Paul in Acts 21:17-26?
- What causes the riot against Paul in Acts 21:27-30?
- How is Paul protected during his arrest in Acts 21:31-36?

Something to Learn

Key Insights:

* Acts 21 shows Paul's resolve to follow God's will; Jerusalem. Agabus also appeared and prophesied back in Acts 11.

Discussion Questions:

- Why does Paul persist despite warnings in Acts 21:1-16?
- What do you think James and the Jerusalem leaders were trying to accomplish by having Paul pay the expenses not only for himself but for others in Acts 21:17-26?
- What can we learn from the crowd's uproar in Acts 21:27-36?
- Why do you suppose Paul wants to address the crowd himself in Acts 21:37-40?

Something to Take Home

- The believers prayed for Paul in Acts 21:5 as he was in the midst of his missionary travels. How or when can we do something similar?
- Paul followed God's call in Acts 21:14. When have you had to go on despite potential problems or what problems to you think you may soon have to face.?
